

DISSIDENT IRISH REPUBLICANS - THE CANCER WITHIN!!

The last 12 months has seen a rise in the level of activity from within the various factions of republicanism-murder, attempted murder, weapons smuggling, bomb making, fire bomb attacks and several high profile terrorist cases at court in relation to "dissident" republicans! "Collectively" these groups have learnt to better co-ordinate themselves and increase their terrorist ability throughout Ulster. Below is just a number of incidents that has added to this on-going sinister threat posed:

- 14 Sept 08: Anti-Terrorist Police in Lithuania are seeking the extradition of a Co Louth man they believe is linked to an alleged attempt by dissident republicans to purchase arms in the Eastern bloc.
- 16 Sept 08: Dissident republicans arrested in Crossmaglen, Co Armagh, after a device and terrorist equipment was found.
- 17 Sept 08: Dissident republicans gun attack on the outskirts of West Belfast, 5 injured.
- 18 Sept 08: A pipe bomb was made safe in Co Tyrone, after an "unsuspecting" member of the public brought it to the station.
- 20 Sept 08: Dissident republican from Co Fermanagh, John Connolly (32) from Newtonbutler, has been identified as the leader of the RIRA.
- 5 October 08: Oglagh na hEireann (OHN) claim responsibility for planting a 100lb bomb in Jonesborough.
- 5 October 08: RIRA issue death threats to suspected drug-dealers in Londonderry.
- 7 October 08: A roadside bomb in Wattlebridge Road, Newtonbutler was defused by the Army.
- 11 October 08: A man was shot in both legs during an attack in West Belfast.
- 23 October 08: Dissident republicans organise a night of rioting in Craigavon after police arrest two dissident republicans.
- 7 Mar 09: Two British soldiers killed at Massereene Army Barracks, Antrim, by the RIRA.
- 9 Mar 09: Policeman shot dead by the CIRA, Lismore Manor, Graigavon.



The recent return of security checkpoints and house searches by the PSNI highlight the threat posed by these terrorists. Dissident republican activity is a focal point of violent historical republicanism for the perceived disenfranchised, that as history has shown can grow very quickly out of control.
